

COVID -19 IF YOU ARE ASSISTED BY THE AIDE AUX MIGRANTS DEPARTMENT THIS INFORMATION CONCERNS YOU

The monthly financial allowance will be delivered as usual. The housing centres will remain open. While the coronavirus crisis goes on, the Hospice général will keep assisting its beneficiaries.

For sanitary reasons, the offices located avenue Eugène-Lance and Bouchet are temporarily closed. However, all social workers are still in activity and will answer your queries. They will be available through different means (telephone, emails, WhatsApp).

The monthly allowances will be processed at the usual date. No payment will be stopped, even in cases of missing documents.
